Notes:

Doctoral students write and present three (3) academic reports (essays), one for each academic year (I, II, III). They are expected to defend them publicly every year and to report on their research progress.

After each public defense of the report, the Ph.D. Committee Chair and the members of the Doctoral Supervisory Committee sign a document in which they include their suggestions and recommendations for the doctoral student who will integrate / address them in the final version of the Ph.D. thesis.

During the 2nd and the 3rd year of doctoral studies, Ph.D. students publish one academic article that reflects their research.

In the eventuality that a Ph.D. student publishes more than one academic article / year, the number of credits assigned for publication will go to the article recommended by the Ph.D. Committee Chair (in the individual research program it will be mentioned only the article / conference for which the doctoral student is awarded credits),
